





What is funded?

- Quality, curricula, teachers training and more SP cooperation (employers involvement)
 - **Development of National Qualification Frameworks (NQFs)**
 - Strengthening VET (& CVT) provision centres and sectoral approaches to lifelong learning
 - Modernization, expantion and connection of VET to LLL
 - Empowerment of regional actors in cooperation with sectors for skills matching
 - Practical skills- work based learning/apprenticeships, introduction of key competencies in VET curricula
 - ► Enhancement of VET Financing & Funding i.e. Voucher schemes and other mechanisms
